Students in the program focus on concepts in studio production, electronic news gathering and field production (ENG/EFP), Short film/ documentary production, and live multi-camera production. The successful candidate will have demonstrated skills in all four core areas as presented by the curriculum.

Required and Preferred Qualifications

The candidate will possess the following skills and mindsets:

- Post Secondary certification in Broadcasting, Digital Media or A/V Production required
- Permanent Teacher Certificate or eligible for Limited Teacher Permit required
- Demonstrated teaching experience and/or instructor training required
- Firm understanding and experience with experiential education, project-based learning, and studio environments
- Strong understanding of processes in design and planning for both single camera and multi-camera productions
- Knowledge of film and broadcasting theory in lighting, sound, story and script development, storyboarding, visual effects, audio effects, and post-production workflows.
- Strong skills in video editing in a mixed Windows PC and Mac environment. Preferred experience in the Adobe Suite of applications
- Understanding of live multi-camera video production and current video switching systems (Software based), graphics systems, and replay systems
- Understanding of video production hardware such as tripods, microphones, convertors, splitters, and encoders
- Strong skills and knowledge of camera systems ranging from DSLRs to prosumer class broadcast camera systems
- Knowledge of current broadcast video protocols and standards (Both conventional and network based)

- Industry experience in film/broadcasting
- Understanding and working knowledge of small networks
- HTML, CSS and Web programming skills
- Video and audio cable fabrication, repair, and maintenance
- Understanding of Mac Operating systems
