Get **BEYOND** Grade 12 **NOW** with a head start on your post-secondary education!





Did you know that two of every three Seven Oaks students continue their education after graduation?

Here in Seven Oaks School Division, we take great pride in the educational opportunities we provide to our students. The Beyond Grade 12 NOW Program is one of the many ways in which we help our students get ahead faster. With the ability to learn and study at a university or college level today, our students are getting a head start.

Beyond Grade 12 NOW is a unique opportunity for Seven Oaks students to earn university and college credits in partnership with the University of Winnipeg, Université de Saint-Boniface, and Red River College, while they are still in high school.

These courses are free and are considered dual credits, meaning they count for high school graduation and university or college credit with our partner institutions. In almost all cases, these credits are transferable between any post-secondary institution!



How does it work?

All Beyond Grade 12 NOW courses will:

- Follow Canadian university or college curriculum
- Be taught by university or college accredited professors/instructors (which in many cases includes our own teachers!)
- Be recognized by Canadian universities and colleges (with exceptions)

When are courses offered?

- First semester (September to January)
- Second semester (February to June)

Is there a cost for Beyond Grade 12 NOW courses?

No, costs are covered by Seven Oaks School Division. Beyond Grade 12 NOW course enrolment is free for students and represents a significant cost reduction to a student's post-secondary program. Beyond Grade 12 NOW also helps you get a head start, while freeing up space in your first-year schedule.

When can I begin courses?

Students must have completed 22 high school credits (maintaining a 70% academic average) or have the permission of their school counsellor to enroll.

Can I withdraw from a course?

If you decide that a Beyond Grade 12 NOW course is not for you, you can withdraw up to two weeks prior to the final exam and university or college transcripts will not include the course (this does not apply in all cases, so be sure to inquire when you register).

We are always looking to expand our programming. Be sure to check with your school to see what is being offered this year.

University and college courses offered may include:
