TALLGRASS PRAIRIE RESTORATION

In May & June we experienced perfect conditions to seed Indigenous, Tallgrass Prairie grasses and flowers over 30 of the 49 acres. This seeding is done by broadcasting (scattering seeds) followed by "harrowing" (like raking) to incorporate seed into the soil, or by drill seeding (using a seeder to place the seed at a specific depth). Now, we hope for regular rain and start watching for germination!



ADDING MEDICINES, DIVERSITY, AND SHELTER

Cultural Education learners influenced the land stewardship action plan for the area surrounding the Tipi and Sweat Lodge. They requested medicines that are used in ceremony, plants to beautify, and trees to create shelter from wind and privacy.

In spring, part 1 of 2 of our tree and shrub orders arrived! We had the joy of working with EAs to help plant 150 trees near the ceremonial spaces.

LEARNING AT HOME


