

Manitoba Adult Literacy Program

With supportive teachers and flexible programs to meet your needs, you can earn certificates of completion and credits towards a grade 12 diploma – all while refreshing and/or building literacy and numeracy skills and concepts as well as skills for your career, school, or personal goals.

Mature Student Diploma

Earn credits for Grade 12 Math and English, two electives and four additional Grade 9-12 credits with this fast-track, 8-credit, fully recognized high school diploma program.

CEAL (Cohort of Experiential Adult Learners)

Earn 2 to 4 grade 12 credits and learn by doing in this fast-paced, hands-on, project-based, exploratory, student-centred, independent learning environment. CEAL runs for 8 weeks, Monday through Thursday for 3 hours per day, 4 days per week. The program incorporates English, Cinema as a Witness to Modern History, and Global Issues. Learners can also attain credits in Career Development, Law, Biology, Psychology, and Physical/Health Education.

CVE (Cooperative Vocational Education) Heavy Construction

If you are interested in heavy duty mechanics, machinery operation, or surveying, you can gain in-class theory and on-the-job training in this 34-week course. As an introduction to the heavy construction industry, this program can open doors to your first job.
