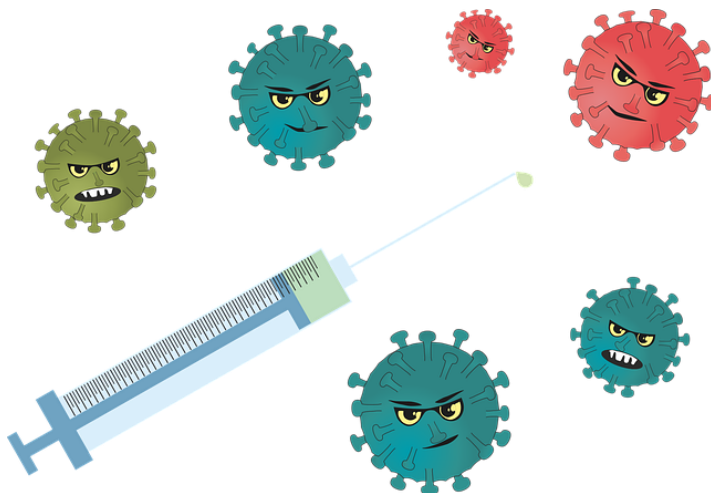
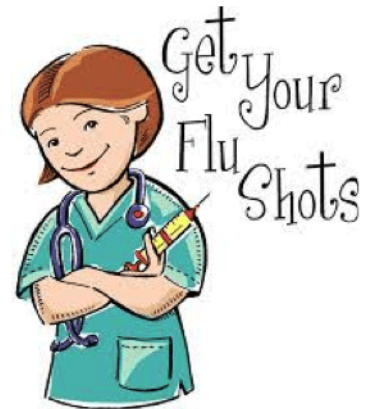

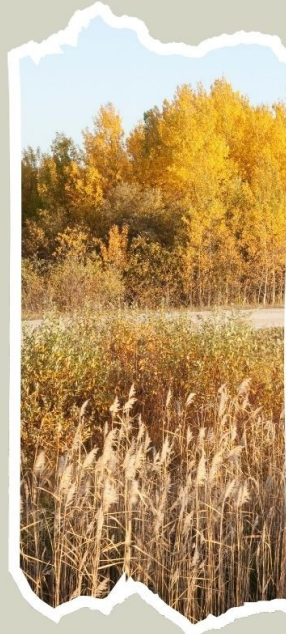
WRITE OUT, MANITOBA!
