

It is estimated that over 1, 300 people experienced homelessness last year. With the months getting colder, and winter soon coming, we are asking for families to consider those in need.


In the spirit of generosity, we are welcoming you to make donations that can help keep people warm this winter. You can help in one of two ways:


Mitten Book Bash! The Free Book Party is BACK!






We are pleased to announce that École Constable Finney School will be hosting a **Free Book Party** during family conferences **November 21 and 22!**

Write Out, Manitoba! is designed by educators as a resource for classrooms and communities. All are invited to participate!






