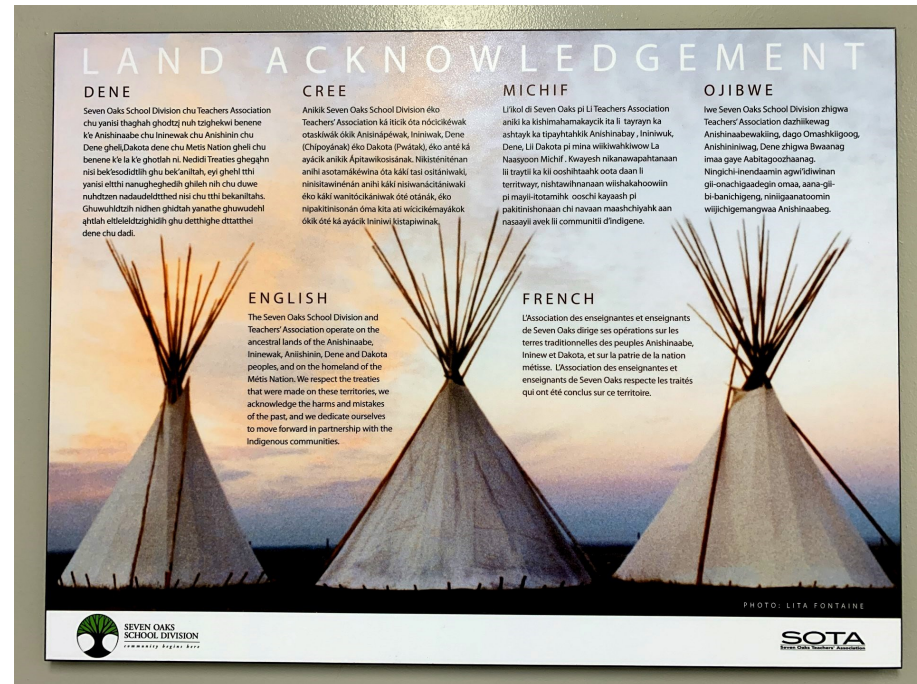

We acknowledge that we are a school on treaty 1 land, the traditional territory of the Ojibwe and homeland of the Metis Nation.

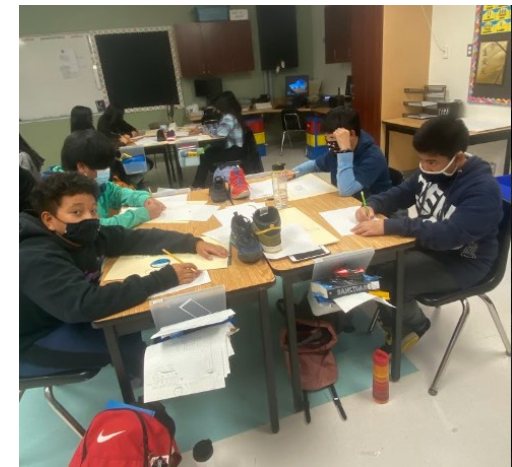

- Leila North is comprised of 467 students and 58 staff members.
- We are a dual track middle school with grades 6-8. We have 11 classrooms in the English Program and 11 classrooms in the French Immersion Program.
- All students at Leila North take English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, French, Physical Education, and TAA (Technology and Applied Arts). Students also have the option to take Band, Exploratory, Choir, and Fiddle.

 - ♦ Reconciliation



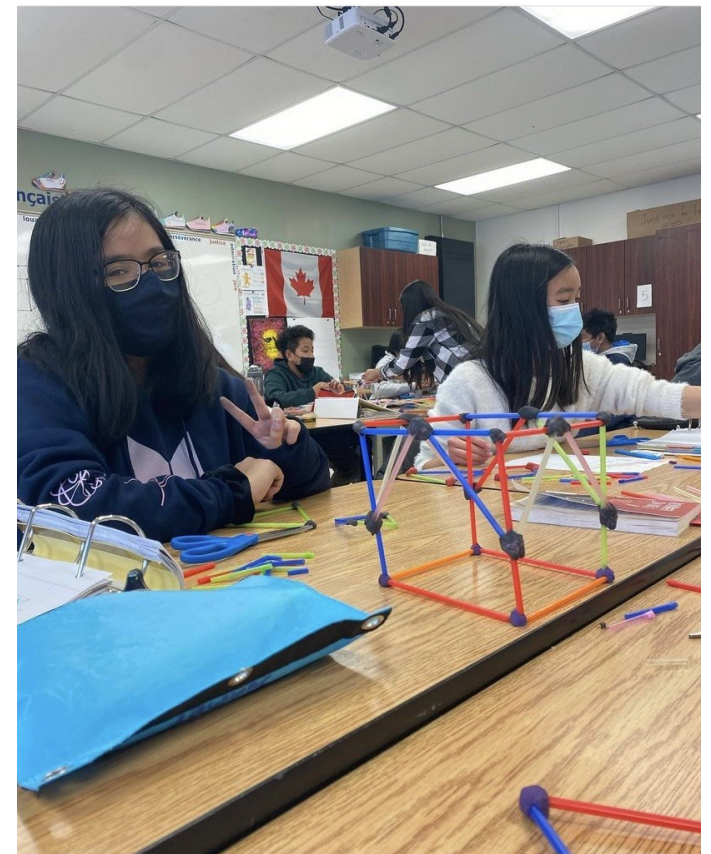
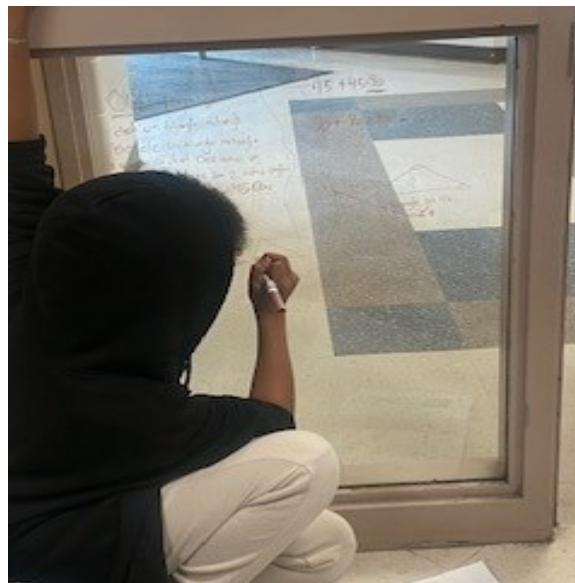

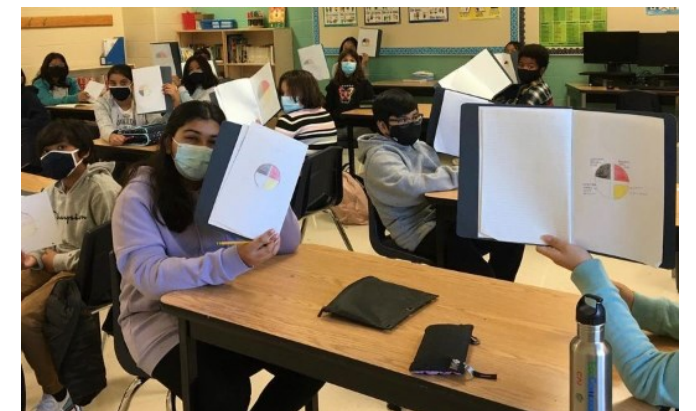
