Dear Families.

Our kindergarten Holiday Concert will take place tomorrow (Tuesday) in the school gym. Kindergarten students can be dropped off in their classrooms at 5:45. The gym doors will open at 5:45 for families to find a seat. Kindergarten students will perform and then go back to the classrooms. Families will pick up their child from their classroom and then return to the gym for snacks.

The Christmas Concerts for grades 1-8 will take place on Wednesday at the Seven Oaks Performing Arts Centre (SOPAC) located at Garden City Collegiate at 711 Jefferson Avenue. Parking is available for families on the street. There is no parking in the Garden City Collegiate parking lots during the daytime performances. **Seating for each evening concert will be very limited.** We look forward to welcoming parents for evening performances. **Extended families and grandparents should attend daytime performances.** Students will be bussed to and from daytime concerts.

The evening concert for grade 1/2 classes will take place at 5:30. Students should arrive at 5:15 and go to rooms indicated on signs in the lobby.

The evening concert for grade 3/4 classes will take place at 6:30. Students should arrive at 6:15 and follow signs to go to the Garden City Commons.

The evening concert for grade 5-8 students will take place at 8:00. Students should arrive at 7:45 and go to rooms indicated on signs in the lobby.

Teachers will supervise students during their concert performance. Children must remain with parents after their concert as there will be no childcare afterward.

Students can be picked up in their assigned spaces after each concert.

Friday will be our annual student Pancake Breakfast. For Friday, each student will need to bring a reusable plastic plate, cup and cutlery in a zipper bag. Students can begin bringing in their bag tomorrow.

West St. Paul School network will be down tomorrow, Tuesday, Dec 17th, at 1:00 p.m. Manitoba Highways will be relocating the Seven Oaks fibre into the school to finish their road construction in the area.
